

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FUNDING - 2018  
RESIDENTS OF THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF SHELBY**

A Public Hearing has been scheduled for Tuesday, January 16, 2018 at 7:00 P.M. in the Shelby Township Municipal Building, 52700 Van Dyke, Shelby Township, Michigan 48316.

The purpose of the public hearing is to obtain the views of citizens concerning community development and housing needs, as required by the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended.

The Charter Township of Shelby will be receiving an estimated \$174,950 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Funds for Fiscal Year (FY) 2018 from the Macomb "Urban County" Program.

The Township will be considering the installation of sidewalks in the southwest quadrant of the community for 2018. Streets that will be considered for sidewalks this year include Wakefield, Cornwall, Kenmore, Cumberland, Joseph or Gable Inn.

Federal guidelines require that maximum priority be given to activities, which will benefit low or moderate-income families, or aid in the prevention of slums or blight. A variety of projects are eligible for community development funding, these include the following:

- Property Acquisition
- Code Enforcement
- Planning & Administration
- Handicapped Barrier Removal
- Rehabilitation of Buildings
- Housing Rehabilitation
- Public Facilities
- Public Infrastructure
- Public Services

Citizens residing in blighted areas or lower income persons are encouraged to participate.
