

Property Tax Billing and Collection

The Tax Bill

The Shelby Township tax bill is a one page, letter sized document with a tear-off return payment coupon on the bottom. Please use the provided return envelope when mailing your payment, with the mailing address showing in the window. The mailing address is for our bank's processing center in Detroit. If a mortgage/escrow company pays your taxes, you will receive an informational tax bill for your records.

When are taxes due?

Summer taxes become due on July 1st and are payable without penalty until September 14th. After September 14th, a 1% late fee is assessed for September. An additional 1% is assessed the first of each month thereafter through February 28th of the following year.

Winter taxes become due on December 1st and are payable without penalty until February 28th. On March 1st, all unpaid taxes are forwarded as 'delinquent' to the Macomb County Treasurer for payment, with additional penalties assessed by the County Treasurer.

Where can taxes be paid?

Tax payments can be made at the Treasurer's Office in the Township Municipal Building. Taxes that are not past due can also be paid at the following banks in Shelby Township:

- Comerica Bank
- Fifth Third Bank

Please bring the entire tax bill when paying in person. For holiday closings and during the last two weeks of the tax collection period, a drop box is available on a 24-hour basis next to the Police Desk on the lower level of the Municipal Building.

How can changes be made to the property tax information?

The Treasurer's Office can only make changes to mortgage/escrow company information, which must be requested in writing. All other changes should be requested of the Assessing department.

Does a mortgage/escrow company pay your taxes?

It is important to make sure the Treasurer's Department has the correct mortgage/escrow company name and address if your mortgage company pays your taxes. If you have recently refinanced your home with a different mortgage company, the Treasurer's Department may not have that change.

Can taxes be paid with a credit card?

Property taxes may be paid with a credit card by telephone or Internet only. To pay by telephone, call 1-800-272-9829. The jurisdiction code for Shelby Township is 3276. To pay online, visit www.officialpayments.com, or use the link on the Treasurer's home page at www.shelbytwp.org.

Please note: This service to pay taxes by way of credit card is provided by a third party company named Official Payments Corporation. This independent third party company will charge the taxpayer a fee to use its service. However, unless or until taxes are paid by way of authorization from the credit card company, those taxes remain the taxpayer's liability.
